
## **CONTINUING GOOD FIGURES**

The July figures indicate international visitors returning and domestic tourism up.

# INTERNATIONAL VISITORS RETURNING

Compared with pre-Covid figures (i.e. 2019), international terminal figures for July are now back up to about 30%. Domestic terminal figures are close to 100%. Taking into account that international visitor traffic passing through the domestic terminal is not likely to be back to normal indicates that domestic air visitation to the region is probably above pre-Covid levels.

Chart 1 – Airport Passenger Movements 2020/21/22 - Percentage Change on pre-Covid 2019 – Cairns Airport



#### SINGLE TOUCH PAYROLL – JOBS INDEX – CONTINUING MILD GROWTH

The Jobs Index based on the Single Touch Payroll reporting system continues to indicate that in the Cairns region, there is mild growth on the previous year.



Chart 3 - Numbers Receiving JobSeeker & Youth Allowance (Other) Payments, Cairns SA4 Region



### **CONSTRUCTION – HOME BUILDING APPROVALS JUMP**

The number of single dwelling approvals registered by Cairns Regional Council jumped up in July to the highest July figures in four years and well above those of more recent months. August figures now available, do not indicate this is a trend.
