Statistical Note

GRP TROPICAL NORTH EAST AUSTRALIA SUPER REGION COMPARED

Australia's great Tropical NorthEast Super Region is now recording a value of Gross Regional Product (GRP) of \$90bn a year. With a residential population passing the one (1) million mark, the NorthEast Super Region is one of Australia's leading regions for Gross Regional Product (GRP) per capita and exceeded only by the State of Western Australia and the Commonwealth Territories (the ACT and Northern Territory).

The Tropical NorthEast Australia Super Region (see Map) is taken to be composed of the four (4) major tropical regions based on <u>Cairns</u> and the Tropical Far North region; <u>Townsville</u> and the North and NorthWest regions; the <u>Mackay</u>/Issac/Whitsunday region; and the <u>Rockhampton</u>, Central and Central West regions.



The Tropical NorthEast Super Region covers some 73% of the area of the State of Queensland. Per capita GRP in the Tropical NorthEast Super Region at \$89,500 is higher than the southern section of the State as well as New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia. Total Gross Regional Product of the Tropical NorthEast Australia Super Region is now about 2.4 times that of the State of Tasmania. On a per capita basis, the Tropical NorthEast Australia Super Region at \$90,000 compares with Tasmania's \$69,000, i.e. about 30% higher.

The following table gives estimates of Gross Domestic/ State/ Regional Product for Australian states and territories compared with estimates for the Tropical NorthEast Australia Super Region in 2021-22 along with estimated residential populations in 2022 and estimates of Gross Domestic/ State/ Regional Product per capita.

The figures are in order of per capita values. Chart illustrates.


